STEP 2: Designed curriculum is finalized in CDW.


STEP 3: Curriculum is approved in BoS.

iii. Describe any good practice/s of the institution pertaining to the Outcome based education (OBE) in view of NEP 2020.

The various OBE related Good practices adopted at YCCE in view of NEP 2020 are as discussed below.

#### 1. Interdisciplinary and Multidisciplinary projects

2. **Cornerstone Project**: The purpose of the cornerstone projects is to introduce the students to their future professional role as engineers. The project spans may be First year or can be extended up to final year. The primary aim is to teach methodology and to enable the students to practice and improve teamwork skills and Project Based Learning.

Each team (Max 3 students) is assigned one faculty member. In this project phase the students are assigned individual roles such as project leader, student responsible for external contacts, student responsible for documentation, etc.

Each team is assigned the task/problem definition of an innovative product/services that satisfied a particular need specified by the mentors.(Problem definition can be given by students also)

- 3. **Project Quality Assurance Initiative (PQAI)**: This activity is planned and conducted for overall improvement of the Quality of Projects, so that tangible outcomes can be targeted through Qualitative Assessment of project
- 4. **Campus Recruitment Training (CRT):** An Exclusive training program of 45 days for final year students provides detail insight about preparedness for placement activity.
- 5. **YCCE Eagles**: "Eagles of YCCE" project will consist of students from 1st year, selected through a 3-level selection process. All students admitted to first year of YCCE will be eligible to participate in this selection process. These selected students of YCCE will become the Eagles of YCCE who will undergo a free of cost 400 plus hours specialized training apart from their regular academics. This training

will prepare them for getting placements in dream global companies with high salary packages.

This specialized training will be mainly divided into following three levels:

- 1) Foundation Training
- 2) Technical Skills training (IT)
- 3) Industry Specific training.

This training will be imparted by expert trainers and will be monitored and assessed by experienced senior faculties, industry experts and reputed agencies.
