The Principal, YCCE, Member Secretary of the BoM, Dr. U.P. Waghe, welcomed all the members and invitees of the Board of Management for the 30th BoM meeting of YCCE. The following agenda items were discussed in the BoM meeting:

Item No. 1 : Confirmation to the minutes of the 29th BOM meeting held on 11th October 2022.

The Principal, Member Secretary, BOM informed that the Draft Minutes of the 29th meeting of Board of Management held on 11th October 2022 were circulated to all the members of the BOM, requesting them to suggest modification(s) / correction(s) if any. Since no comments were received from the BoM members, Member Secretary requested Hon'ble members to approve the minutes. The BoM approved and confirmed minutes unanimously.

Item No.2: Action Taken Report to the Minutes of the last Board of Management meeting held on 11th October 2022.

The action taken report on the actionable points of the last meeting of the Board of Management held on 27th September 2021 was placed before the BOM. The Board of Management went through the report.

The Board of Management went through the report and expressed their satisfaction on the same. BoM accepted the Action taken Report.

Item No. 3: To consider report of the Principal on status of admissions.

The status of admission for session 2022-23 of 1st year, 2nd year (4th Sem), 3rd year (6th Sem) & 4th Year (8th Sem) B.Tech. / B.E., and M.Tech 1st year (1st Sem) and 2nd year (4th Sem) presented by the Principal was reviewed in the meeting.

The Principal informed that there are total 5710 students on roll against intake of 4740 in B.Tech./B.E. programme. (I, II / III & IV Year U.G..) as well as a total of 50 students on roll against intake of 182 students under M.Tech programs.

With these observations, the report of the Principal on status of admissions was noted by the BoM.

Item No. 4: To consider the report of the Principal on the academic performance of students.

The Member Secretary, BoM informed the Hon'ble Chair that, the Examination of B.Tech. 1st year (1st Sem A & B) under the Autonomy is conducted and result for the same is awaited, whereas the result of Odd Term for 2nd year (3rd Sem), 3rd year (5th Sem) and 4th year (7th Sem) of B.Tech./ B.E. programs was presented before BoM members. The examination of M.Tech. 1st Sem. was also conducted but result for the same is awaited. The BoM members reviewed the result of 3rd Sem. M. Tech. programs.

The report of the Principal on academic performance of students was noted with satisfaction by the BoM.

Item No. 5: To consider any matter in so far as it enhances the academic atmosphere of the institution.

The BoM went through the report No. 25 of Dean (Academic Matters) for Odd Term 2022-23 for the period of July 2022 to January 2023; presented by Dr. A.V. Patil, Dean (Academic Matters) –

The report highlighted on –

- Registration of Regular Students in Odd Term 2022-23 – Total 5710 (including 47 re-admissions) UG regular and 50 PG Regular students were registered in Odd Term 2022-23.
- Readmissions / Re-registrations in Odd Term 2022-23 – Total 47 readmissions and 07 re-registration have been done.
- Academic Calendars for UG and PG programs – were published before the commencement of the Odd Term 2022-23. As the admissions are done in this term and there was a delay in admission process at State Government level, the academic Calendars for I YR of UG and PG program were published separately.

- Feedback for UG & PG – The feedback on the teaching Learning Process is obtained from students for Session 2022-23 to understand the effectiveness and also to remove the problems in the T&L Process. The feedback is obtained twice in a semester, the in-Semester feedback after 5-6 weeks of teaching and end-Semester feedback after 13-14 weeks of teaching.
- Parent Teacher Meets – The Parent Teacher Meeting was held on 19/11/2022 and 14/01/2023 during the Odd Term 2022-23.
- During Odd Term 2022-23, the students who failed to fulfill the criteria for attendance were detained as per the provisions of Academic Regulation. The detention of students was not carried out as per the guideline of GoM, UGC & RTMNU.
- Special Mentoring Scheme during Odd Term 2022-23 - the students who failed to fulfill the criteria for attendance were detained and registered for Special Mentoring scheme (SMS).
- BoS meetings were conducted by various departments to review curriculum.
- Industry Research Professor Scheme conducted during Odd Term 2022-23 by various department was presented which was reviewed by the BoM members.
- Details of Students Under Exchange Programme with COEP, Pune, VJTI, Mumbai and IIIT, Nagpur was presented and reviewed by the BoM members.
- Faculty Position – Total 326 faculty in various department of the UG and PG Programmes were engaged.
- Details of Open Electives-I & II offered for various departments, credit transfer was also reviewed by BoM members.
- Details of various Events Held in YCCE during 2022-23 like First Year Induction Programme and Workshop/Seminar organized by the departments was reviewed by the BoM members.

With this the BoM accepted the report of Dean (Academic Matters) for Odd Term of 2022-23.

The Report of Controller of Examination, YCCE:

The BoM went through the report of CoE for Odd Term of 2022-23 for the period from July 2022 to March-2023; as presented by Prof. D.R. Raut, CoE, which highlighted on–

- Examination Results declaration.
- Result Analysis for the ESE ODD Term 2022-23.
- List of Semester Toppers ESE ODD Term 2022-23.
- List of Students eligible for award of degree after ODD-ESE-2022-23
- While reviewing the report of Unfair Means Cases for ESE 2022-23, BoM Member Shri Sameerji Meghe pointed out the increase in number of Unfair Means Cases and after deliberation in length he directed to take strict steps in order to minimize the Unfair Mean cases.
- Question Paper Setting & Moderation for ESE ODD- 2022-2023.
- Grievances after Evaluation of Answer Books.

With these observations, the report the COE was accepted and approved by the BoM.

Item No.6 : To consider the proposals of the Principal for Academic Performance and Capacity Building of the staff.

The highlights and data in respect of major programs organized, training programs, workshops organized, Publications in Conferences, participation of teaching staff in various events, major achievement / awards of staff, Paper publications, Ph.D. awarded to staff etc. from 15th October 2022 to till date was presented.

The information presented by the Principal, YCCE were reviewed and noted by BoM.

Item No. 7: To consider any proposal for Expansion of Educational Activities to be made to the Council / Govt. / Affiliating Body.

1. The Principal-Member Secretary informed that the institute has submitted online proposal for First Affiliation of newly started UG Programme B.Tech. CSE (IoT) started from A.Y. 2022-23. RTM Nagpur University granted First Affiliation to the above UG programme.

2. The institution has also submitted online proposal to RTM Nagpur University for Continuation of Affiliation including new 5 UG programmes as well as all the existing affiliated programmes i.e. UG & PG both from academic session 2023-24 on 16th March 2023
3. The institute has applied for change in nomenclature of following PG-M.Tech. programmes from A.Y. 2023-24

The Expert Committee constituted by RTM Nagpur University under the Chairmanship of Dr. Narendra Bawane. The Expert Committee visited institution on 10.12.2022 for verification. RTM Nagpur University has issued NOC for new nomenclature.

RTM Nagpur University has issued NOC for the same.
5. The institution is also applying to start new PG Programme 'Master of Business Administration' (MBA) with intake of 60 from Academic Session 2023-24.
6. The institute has also applied for start of new UG-B.Tech. programme Electronics Engineering (VLSI Design & Technology) intake of 60 and PG-M.Tech. programme Electronics Communication Engineering (VLSI Design) intake of 12 from Academic Session 2023-24.

The BoM members unanimously approved the above proposal and authorized Principal-Member Secretary to take appropriate decision in this regard.

The committee members noted the joining and resignations and approved the report.

2) To consider and approve staff requirements with financial impact for the academic year 2023-24.

The committee members were briefed that, as per latest Approval Process Handbook for 2023-24, faculty student ratio has been revised by AICTE for undergraduate programmes from the ratio of 1:15 to new ratio of 1:20, resulted in decline in faculty requirements. Therefore, in the next academic year 2023-24, the intake for UG shall be 4980 (1260 stu-1st yr, 1260 stu -2nd yr, 1260 stu - 3rd year and 1200 stu for final year) and thereby **requirement of total nos of faculty for UG programme shall be 249 Nos.**

However, for post graduate programmes, faculty student ratio has been continued as 1:15 and therefore, considering next year intake of 156 students (78 stu - 1st year + 78 stu – 2nd year), faculty requirement shall **be 11 staff only.**

Therefore, total faculty strength requirement shall be 260 nos.

The committee members were updated that presently the Institute has **217** full time regular faculty members.

Due to merger of IT and CSE branches of RGCER, existing 08 faculty members of RGCER shall be adjusted in YCCE from academic year 2023-24, making the figure of **225** available faculty members. The financial burden for above 08 faculty members shall be Rs. 7.73 Lakhs pm. Apart from above, one faculty member deputed to RGCER shall be repatriated, making YCCE's strength of faculty members as **226 for 2023-24.**

The remaining 34 shall be engaged on Adhoc basis. Therefore, approx. financial burden for those 34 faculty shall be 10.20 Lakh pm (considering pm salary @Rs. 30,000 per faculty).

The committee noted the same and directed to fulfill the requirement as per statutory norms, as regards to faculty numbers.

6) To make payment of arrears of DA due to hike in DA rates from 28% to 34% & proposed financial burden on implementation of DA revision from 34% to 38% in 7th Pay commission for eligible staff members.

The committee members were informed that hike in Dearness Allowance (DA) from 28% to 34% effective from 1st July 2021 to 30th Nov 2022 was approved for staff members who are receiving salary as per 7th pay commission. The arrears payable on account of revision of aforementioned DA, to the eligible staff members shall be in the three equal monthly installments i.e. Rs.77.40 Lakhs in Feb'23 month, Rs.77.40 Lakhs in July-23 and Rs.77.40 Lakhs in Oct-23.

It was further submitted that the Govt. of Maharashtra has further made revision in the DA from 34% to 38% from 1st July 2022 in the 7th pay commission and therefore the financial burden on implementation of the same shall be approximately Rs. 8 lakhs per month.

7) To consider & approve proposed budgetary estimates of the college both recurring and non-recurring for the financial year 2022-23.

The budgetary estimates of the college (both recurring and non-recurring) for the financial year 2022-23 were presented before the Finance Committee. This is inclusive of the additional 240 seats intake of Four New courses introduced during academic year 2022-23

After detailed discussion, the Finance Committee approved the budgetary estimates. The abstract of the budget approved for the financial year 2022-23 is as follows:

The Hon'ble Chairman & BoM members unanimously suggested to hold a separate meeting to discuss this issue.


- BoM Member Shri Sameerji Meghe suggested to organise good events like 'Innovation R Us' so that students and faculty get benefited out of it.
