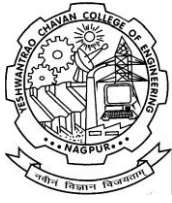

Agenda points:-

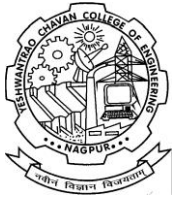
1) To Welcome IQAC Members:

Dr. U.P. Waghe, Principal & Chairman, IQAC, YCCE offered Floral welcome to the members of IQAC for the IQAC Meeting.

He informed the members about the award of NAAC Cycle II accreditation to the institution. He congratulated the Director, IQAC and IQAC Team for their untiring effort during the process of the NAAC accreditation. He also thanked the Management, Stakeholders, functional Heads, faculty and support staff members and the students for their cooperation during the accreditation process.

2) To brief IQAC about the NAAC Accreditation, Quality Profile and NAAC Peer Team report

Dr. A.R. Bhagat Patil, Director IQAC informed the members the 03 member NAAC Peer Team Visited the institution on 13 & 14 May for Cycle II Accreditation. The NAAC granted A++ grade with CGPA 3.6 valid up to 16 May 2027. The CGPA scored by YCCE is the highest score among Engineering colleges in Maharashtra.

He thanked the IQAC members and functional heads of the YCCE for their valuable suggestions and support extended during the complete NAAC accreditation process.

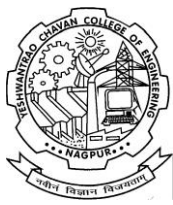
3. To discuss the NAAC Peer Team Report, Analysis and Recommendations

A) Director IQAC, presented the Overall Analysis of the Institution by NAAC Peer Team:

- One of the very old and self-financing autonomous institute permanently affiliated to Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur.
- Good number of NBA accredited programmes and consistently maintain moderate position in NIRF ranking.
- The institute is located in the heart of the city in Nagpur ideally suitable for technical education.
- Good physical and academic infrastructure.
- Qualified, experienced and dedicated faculty and staff with good retention ratio.
- Industry-Institute interaction leading to good placements.
- Good opportunities for the institute for all round development being located in the centre of Nagpur

IQAC members expressed their satisfaction over the analysis by NAAC Peer Team and expressed that the responsibility of the IQAC is increased two-fold and all need to put more hard work to attain newer heights in future.

Hon. Vrindatai Meghe, expresses the need to improve NIRF ranking, and institute need to put focused efforts for the placement of the core branch students.



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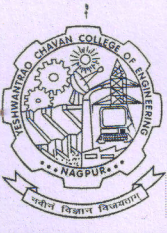
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B) Director IQAC presented the Cycle II Accreditation Peer Team Recommendations:

Recommendations for Quality Enhancement of the Institution

- **The Institute needs to strengthen its Innovation Centre and Research Centre by facilitating enhanced skill development to its students and augmenting research facilities.**
 - Review of facilities available in Incubation Centre & Research Centre
 - Common research lab. with all research-related facilities are available.
 - Utilization of facilities for projects & research work by faculty & scholars.
- **To have a competitive edge and improved brand image, the institute should strive for more MoUs with organizations of repute and collaborations with industry.**
 - MoU's with reputed organizations & industries by each department
 - Ensure activities under the signed MoU's.
- **To enhance the employability of the students in the core areas of engineering by adding more technology driven value added courses in the emerging areas.**
 - Value Added Courses (> 30 Hrs.) in the emerging areas and ensure core branch student's participation in relevant VAC's.
- **To have more institutional funding for promoting research by several means.**
 - In-house funding for research projects, patents & seed money.
- **To encourage and enhance consultancy services on the campus.**
 - Independent Faculty In-charge for consultancy
 - NABL Accreditation of labs of CE & EL Department
 - Develop additional consultancy facility by each department
- **Enhancement of sports and games facilities.**
 - New Gym facility is under process of renewal
 - Trainer/coach guidance
- **To establish a separate hostel for the students.**
 - Management to take decision based on the demand of the hostel facility in campus.
 - The students prefer to stay in the city & nearby places due to good transportation facilities.
- **To introduce short-term courses on bio-medical instrumentation.**
 - Elective course or Certification course in collaboration with Health Colleges/Hospitals to prepare towards NEP 2020 Multidisciplinary/ Interdisciplinary requirement.
- **Eco Friendly campus reflected with the botanical and herbal garden.**
 - Ayurveda College Herbal Garden is on campus.
 - Plantation of Herbal plants in YCCE campus
- **Adequate focus needs to be given on conceptual understanding of the subject.**
 - Periodic Oral feedback SOP to assess the T-L process apart from regular feedback system.
 - Prefer Senior Faculty members for teaching First & Second Year Core Courses.



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It has been decided that Director, IQAC in consultation with the concerned functional heads will prepare and present an action plan in the next meeting.

It was also decided that in view of the NAAC Peer Team recommendations, if required Dean (Planning and Development) will review the AWL, DLA SOP/Formats and Perspective Plan guidelines and make necessary modifications.

Director IQAC, Dr. A.R. Bhagat Patil, informed that IQAC is working on the AQAR 2021-22

4. To discuss Draft Action Plan 2022-23 in accordance with Peer Team Recommendations

Director, IQAC, presented the draft IQAC Action Plan 2022-23 addressing all the quality initiatives planned.

After thorough discussion on the recommendations of NAAC Peer Team and in tune with the proposed strategic plan of the institute, it has been decided in the meeting to include the relevant suggestions of the IQAC members in the IQAC 2022-23 action plan.
