### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO HIGHER SEMESTER

It is Notified for general information for all concerned that the eligibility criteria for admission to higher semester to B.Tech/B.E. students as per YCCE & RTMNU Nagpur is as follows:

Admission to Higher Semester	Particular
For 3rd Semester admission	: Min 60% credits required from 1st & 2nd Semester. <b>(i.e. First Year)</b>
For 5th Semester admission	: First Year clear Pass + Min 60% credit required from 3rd & 4th Semester <b>(i.e. Second Year)</b>
For 7th Semester admission	: First Year clear pass + Second Year clear pass + Min 60% credit required from 5th & 6th Semester <b>(i.e. Third Year)</b>

The eligibility criteria will be as per the SoE applicable to the student and the credits should be considered rounded off to higher side (i.e. 24.3 = 25).

This is for general information to all students that YCCE is implementing the Detention policy as per UGC and of Rashtrasanta Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University (RTMNU), Nagpur Reules and Regulations.

#### Following are the rules of attendance:

- A students must have an **overall 75%** attendance of total number of classes engaged including lectures / tutorials and practical.
- Condonation of attendance can only be considered in case the **overall** attendance of the student is **minimum 60%** and that the deficiency in attendance was due to *circumstances beyond the control of the student.*

It has been observed that students are not attending the lectures in their regular courses and **YCAP courses**. It is especially notified that a minimum of 75% attendance is compulsory, including in **YCAP sessions** and failing to which the students are liable to be detained as per the above rules.
