Sub: Notification for students of Old Scheme of Autonomy (2014)

The Institution has introduced the newer scheme of autonomy called as Autonomy 2018 from the Odd term of 2018-19 session. The New schemes are applicable to all UG and PG programs. The new scheme will, therefore, become applicable to higher semesters/ years progressively as the regular batch moves ahead as shown in column 3 of the table below.

If the students of Autonomy 2014 scheme fail to pass a course in the old scheme, then such students shall be given additional chances. The course content, the question paper format and rules shall remain same as that of Autonomous 2014 scheme. However, this facility will remain in force till limited time as mentioned in the following table which shows the last time the regular students will appear for the examinations and also the last chance for failure students as per old scheme.

Students can appear as ex-students for ESE of Odd and Even terms till the last chance as shown in column 4 of the table above.

There shall be no RESIT examination for Autonomous 2014 scheme students.

If a student fails to clear the course of old scheme by the last chance mentioned above, then he/she shall be absorbed into the Autonomous 2018 (NEW) Scheme as per the Equivalence Table prepared by the respective Board of Studies.
