Sir,

I am directed to state that on consideration of the observations made by the Expert Committee which visited the College on February 28, 1991, the recommendations made by the Western Regional Committee (WRC) at its Third Meeting held on 11.10.91, and the Secretarial review made on the compliance report submitted by the College on 26.12.1992, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has accorded approval to the Nagpur Yuvak Shikshan Sansthan's Yeshwantrao Chavan College of Engineering, Nagpur for conducting the following degree courses in Engineering with the annual intake shown against each from the academic year 1993-94:


The approval given above is subject to the following conditions:

- (1) The College will provide total 21600 sqm. of plinth area for 480 annual intake.

- (2) The teaching staff requirement for 400 annual intake will be 102 in the ratio of 1:2:4 (Professor:Asst.Professor:Lecturer). The College shall recruit necessary teaching staff to remove the deficiencies by December, 1994, and submit a compliance report.
- (3) The name for the course in Electronics & Power Engineering is not proper and misleading. The College should take up the matter with the Nagpur University for changing the name of this course to Electrical Engineering and may incorporate minor changes in the syllabi, if required, under intimation to the AICTE.
- (4) The Management including the Governing Council of the College shall be constituted as per the AICTE guidelines and also the Chairman shall be appointed as per the AICTE guidelines.
- (5) Admissions shall be made on merit as per the guidelines issued by the AICTE and no capitation or donation of any kind shall be charged for admissions.
- (6) The tuition and other fees shall be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
- (7) The teaching staff shall be recruited on an All India basis by open selection, and as per procedure, qualifications, experience, etc. as prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. State-based selection would be permissible for such posts for which the State Government prescribes "State-based selection" as a general policy.
- (8) The accounts of the College shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant and be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorized by it.
- (9) The College shall follow strictly any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.
- (10) The technical supporting staff shall be recruited to come at par with the AICTE norms within one year.
- (11) No new course shall be started in the Engineering College without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (12) The intake in any year shall not be altered without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- (13) For considering approval of any other educational institutions run by the same Society or its sister organisation, the academic performance of this institution and the progress made by the Management in removing the deficiencies will be taken into consideration.


