EXIT FEEDBACK 2021-22

The Exit Feedback was conducted to assess the final satisfaction level of students about the processes and facilities of the institution. The detailed analysis is attached for ready reference. The following are the observation which will need attention / corrections in the following items.

1. The overall attainment is on an average 97.59% however more focus should be given on solving of complex engineering problem and relating the knowledge required for economic and environmental issues.
2. The Academics experience is satisfactory. Teaching methodology should be improved to make it more effective and special help should be provided by faculty for preparation of ESE.
3. Evaluation process including assessment methods is excellent. More personal attention should be given during conduct of practicals.
4. Library experience is satisfactory.
5. Functional English, PIM & GEN Next, CRT modules offered to students need a relook as is evident from the low satisfaction index. Teacher guardian scheme needs to be strengthened.
6. Drinking water and washrooms is a cause of concern in all departments.
7. Computing facilities should be made virus free and high speed internet bandwidth & campus wide Wi-Fi should be available in college campus.
8. The support for summer internship should be strengthened by T & P department.
9. Interaction with the students by Accounts, Students Section, Hostel, CoE office and T & P needs improvements.
10. GATE and CAT are the most favoured competitive examinations taken by students.
11. Large number of students would like to remain contact with the college through Email & Whatsapp.
