Guidelines for Grace Marks (From session 22-23)

Examinee can get Grace Marks as follows

Maximum 3 marks per course in a semester.

Maximum 2 courses in a semester.

Conditions for 'applying grace marks'

- If examinee clears all courses except one or two.
- If Student clears that semester, after applying grace.

Conditions for 'not applying grace marks'

- If student score less than 07 marks out of 50 in ESE
- If Student scores 'F' grade in 3 or more courses.
- If Student scores 'I' grade in any of the courses.
- If student score less than 05 marks out of 40 in ESE
- If student score less than 09 marks out of 60 in ESE

Grade allotment For Course with Grace.

- 'D' grade is allotted by default after applying grace.

Application by student is not required for applying grace.
