Equivalent course from Old SOE (scheme of exam) to New SOE

There are some old students who are fail in one or more courses from old SOE and as on today that SOE is merged in subsequent New SOE.

SOE 202.1 or SOE 203.1 → SOE 22 → SOE23

The equivalent course may be at the same semester level or higher/ lower semester level in New SOE.

Hence such students must refer the proper ESE timetable (Backlog/Resit ESE) of proper semester of the equivalent course and participate in the exam accordingly.

Further, such students must visit Pre exam section well in advance along with relevant exam admit card and fill up the *Equivalent course chart* to help seating arrangements.

For Example:-

If a student fails in 3 courses of 5th Semester and if one course is equivalent to fourth semester's course, another course is equivalent to fifth semester's course and third course is equivalent to sixth semester's course, then such a student will appear the equivalent courses of those semester as per the relevant Time Table of Backlog / Re-sit ESE available on YCCE Website.

As the student is basically failed in Semester 5, he should write seat no. of Sem 5 on Answer book. Also, write the course code and course name of Sem 5 and in Bracket student should write course code of equivalent semester so that his answer book will be evaluated as per respective equivalent question paper. Such students are not eligible for regular ESE exam.

However, if the student re-register's for any course/s for attending classes / MSE / TA such students should participate with regular students in ESE ODD or ESE EVEN as per the registered session.
